**STATEMENT
IN OBSERVANCE OF
TEEN DATING VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS MONTH**

Whereas, dating violence is a pattern of abusive behaviors used to exert power and control over a dating partner; and

Whereas, 1 in 3 adolescents in the United States is a victim of physical, emotional or verbal abuse from a dating partner, a figure that far exceeds victimization rates for other types of violence affecting youth; and

Whereas, 1 in 10 high school students has been purposefully hit, slapped or physically hurt by a boyfriend or girlfriend, teenagers between the ages of 16 and 19 are 3.5 times more likely than the general public to be victims of sexual abuse; and

Whereas, 52% of teens who experience digital abuse are also physically or sexually abused by a dating partner; and

Whereas, only 33% of teens who are in an abusive relationship ever tell anyone about the abuse, and 81% of parents believe teen dating violence is not an issue or admit they do not know if it is an issue; and

Whereas, 69.5% of women and 53.6% of men who have been physically or sexually abused, or stalked by a dating partner, first experienced abuse between the ages of 11 and 24; and

Whereas, high school students who experience physical violence in a dating relationship are more likely to use drugs and alcohol, are at greater risk of suicide and are much more likely to carry patterns of abuse into future relationships; and

Whereas, by providing young people with relationship skills and by changing attitudes that support violence, we recognize that dating violence can be prevented; and

Whereas, whether it is violence based on sexual orientation, race, ethnicity, or gender, effective public health prevention of this violence will necessitate the consideration and inclusion of such inequalities; and

Whereas, every person has the right to healthy, safe and respectful relationships free from abuse.
